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A REPORT ON

Two Day Training Induction Organized by IQAC, KJSCE For

Newly Joined Faculty Members s

(Wednesday 3rd January 2018 and Thursday 4th January 2018, Venue: B 507)

The purpose of this Induction was to orient the newly joined faculty member to KJSCE environment. They were made aware of the facilities, the various systems, policies, procedures in KJSCE. This was the first time that such a programme was undertaken by KJSCE. The participants were very happy to know the KJSCE at glance in these two days. They appreciated the concept of induction wholeheartedly.

Day 1: 3rd January 2018

The Induction started with the welcome of new faculty members by Dr. Sonali Patil (Coordinator IQAC). She briefed the participants about the programme. She also informed the participants about the different activities of IQAC.

This was followed by address of Dr. Shubha Pandit (Principal). She briefed the participants about the college, the infrastructure, the facilities, etc. She also expressed the expectations of the college from the new faculty members.

[I] First Session: (10.30 AM to 11.45 AM) Talk by By Dr. N. R. Gilke (Vice Principal) and Mr. Mohandas (Administrative Officer)

[Various aspects of Administration and HR in KJSCE: Share of experience]

In this session the participants were given information regarding various administrative and HR procedures and policies of KJSCE. The presentation included information about following:

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[II] Second Session: (11.45 AM to 12.45 PM) Talk by Dr. Manish Potey (Purchase Committee Member)

[Understanding of Purchase procedures at KJSCE]

In this session, Dr Manish Potey explained the procedures related to budget, purchase, write-off etc. He made the participants aware about the different formats used for the same. His presentation typically consisted of following points:

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Fifth Session: (3.45 PM to 5.00 PM) Talk by Dr. Deepak Sharma (Professor, Dept of computer Engg and Sports Incharge)

[Use of ICT in teaching learning]

Dr. Deepak Sharma detailed the participants about the following:
