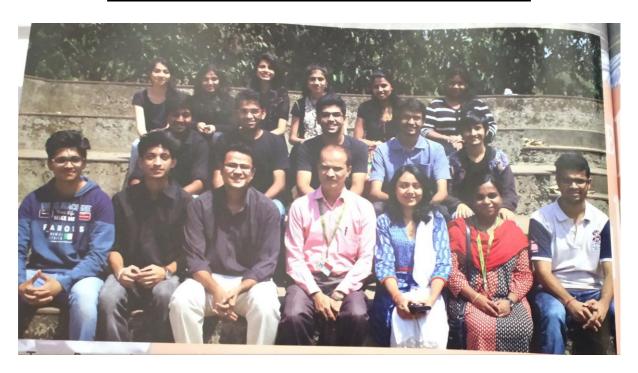
SAHAS ANNUAL REPORT 2015-16
