

SAHAS ANNUAL REPORT 2016-17



The SAHAS council (Student's Association of Humanities and Science) is one of the youngest councils of KJSCE. The council conducted various events in the academic year 2016-17. At SAHAS, we believe in academic excellence, keeping in mind the importance of the co-curricular activities.

The first event organised by SAHAS was an Evaluation Seminar on 31st August 2016, only for First Year engineering students. The purpose of the seminar was to help the first year students get acquainted with the grade system for all four academic years. The seminar was conducted by the Controller of Examination, Mrs Anita Kantute.

The second event that was organised by SAHAS was a fun event "Pic-o-mania", on the second day of Abhyantriki 2016 (1st October 2016). More than 40 teams, of 2 members each, participated in the vent. A list of clues which lead to various locations around the entire Somaiya campus, were given to teams and they were supposed to take a photograph at that spot/place; with the name of the place being clearly visible in the photograph.

SAHAS celebrated Science Day on 28th February, 2017. We asked people all around the campus some basic scientific questions as a rapid fire session. The event was recorded simultaneously.
